

Oswego Figure Skating Club
End of Season Show Participation Policy

The Board of Directors of the Oswego Figure Skating Club provides an opportunity to showcase the talent of the club's skaters at the Basic Skills and Full Club levels!

Seniors: The Club's Show Committee in consultation with the graduating high school skater(s) for that season will decide on the theme of the show. The senior skater(s) will help choose the music for the show opening number in consultation with the committee. All seniors will have the opportunity to skate a solo senior program to music of their choice.

*The Show Committee has the right to limit the number of programs in the show, including senior numbers, due to time constraints.

Opening Number: Home club members who have moved up to full club and are not skating on LTS ice in any capacity are welcome to sign up to participate in the opening number. Because practices are limited, please try and attend all of them. If the coach and/or committee conclude that lack of attendance will impact the overall performance, skaters may be asked to exclude themselves from the opening number. You may be required to purchase a costume to participate in the opening number and refunds for advance payments may be made at the discretion of the committee. Written requests for refunds will be required with a reason for the request and should be made to the committee prior to the dress rehearsal.

Solo/Duet programs: Any LTS or Full Club (Home Club or Non-Home Club) member who competed in a USFSA sanctioned competition with a showcase, free skate or competitive test track program may skate that program or a program of similar length to music that fits the theme of the show. The program length should not be any longer than what you would use in competition. If you have not competed in the past season but you have tested at a free skate level, you are welcome to skate that program or a program of that length to music that fits the theme of the show. Sign-ups are first-come basis after senior skaters and opening music and group music is chosen.

Group programs: The Show Committee will put together groups for those LTS/Full Club skaters that would like to skate in the show but who do not meet the criteria for a solo/duet. The groups will be based on levels passed, ages and discipline. The Show Committee will be responsible for choosing the music, arranging practice times and ensuring a coach is available to work with the group for choreography, etc. You may be required to purchase a costume to participate in the group number and refunds for advance payments may be made at the discretion of the committee. Written requests for refunds will be required with a reason for the request and should be made to the committee prior to the dress rehearsal.
